

Rudloe 'Green'



A proposed transfer of Rudloe Community Centre and the 'Green' from Wiltshire Council to GreenSquare could mean that the Green will be built on. Rudloe Estate could lose its only green community space.

The Green is not protected but could be if it is registered as a Village Green. A first step to its protection (through Wiltshire Council) is for as many people as possible to provide evidence of usage by writing down when and how they have used the Green, whether as children or adults, since the building of Rudloe Estate in the 60s.

It makes no difference whether this usage has been for the whole period or just (a small) part of it, for example in the 60s, 70s, 80s, 90s or since the turn of the century. Once usage information has been gathered, the process of Village Green application can begin. If the application is successful, the Green will be saved for the community and can never be built on.
