Everyday I come home from work there is always children playing football on the Green. The Green is the only safe place for the children to play. It's very popular with the parents sitting on the Green watching their children playing. I've never known there to not be children on the Green.

Debbie Pearce

I have recently moved back into the house but my father has lived here for 31 years so we are both

very familiar with the Green. My father is currently in his 80s and likes to take a stroll around the Green as it is not too far for him. I used to bring my children to visit when they were young and they would play on the Green and the playground. We include the Green as part of a walk for our dog. I can also remember a big group of local residents playing rounders there on a sunny afternoon. There have also been fetes and other events held on the Green and the children made snowmen, fly kites and play football.

Gail Banks

I've lived at Rudloe for 37 years. In this time I have seen the Green being used for firework displays, fetes etc. And most of all children playing football and other outdoor games. It would be a shame for more property to be built there with all other housing estates going on around us taking what view we have.

Hannah Creighton

I have been using the green since 1997. This usage increased on building of the new community centre, with the centre opening directly onto the green in the summer months. Children and adults alike were often seen playing in the playground, playing football or enjoying the green space for social engagements. With plans to start a family, the green supported the reason behind buying my property in 2017, with friends with children enjoying the play park on visits, as well as appreciating the natural beauty of the area. Now having a son of my own, I look forward to enjoying the space with him and his friends in the not too distant future, supporting his physical, mental and social development and well-being. Something that my son will be able to access from an early age due to it being on our doorstep, only benefitting from the aspects of play that is now so lost in our (clearly ever evolving) consumerist and technologically drenched society.

My brothers and I were always playing on the Green with our friends. I bought my own house at 3 Long Close Avenue, Rudloe about 8 years ago. My husband and my 2 children use the Green on a daily basis. My neices and nephews also come to Rudloe and use the Green with us. My parents still live at 22 Long Close Avenue, Rudloe. It's such a fantastic area that we really do need to keep hold of.

Melissa Birkett

I have lived on the estate for approaching 22 years(2 properties) and my family have lived on the estate for 40 plus. As a child myself when visiting my Auntie I oēen used the green and my own daughter has spent many an hour on the green and did in fact take her first

steps there. Just last year (I believe) the air ambulance landed in the middle of the green to attend an emergency on the estate which would have not been possible if it was open to development. It would be a great shame to see this land being built on as it provides the only space we have for the groups of young kids to go. In the summer even into early evening it is used daily by families etc, picnics, football etc.

Phil Beattie

My name is Phil Beattie, I was born in one of the old pre-fab bungalows on Rudloe Estate back in June 1953 and we then moved to the pre-fab bungalows at Boxfields until September 1964 when we moved back to the newly built council estate at Rudloe. I was always keen on playing football and I used the green on an almost daily basis from September 1964 until mid 1975. This was certainly the case during the spring and summer months and especially during the school holidays. I still continued to use the green after mid 1975 but not as often and this was the case up until I got married in 1983. I still live in Rudloe, now in Pine Close so have lived in this area all my life. The use was mainly for playing football along with two of my brothers and also the O'Shea's, Kelly's, Swain's, Cafferty's, and others who lived on the estate. We would use two of the trees which are still at the top of the green as one set of goalposts and we would use our jumpers as the other set of goalposts at the bottom of the green. Sometimes in the summer the green would be used as our cricket pitch and again the same people would be involved. Back then the green only had 4 swings and a roundabout for us to use and not much has changed in this respect in over 50 years. It would be a crying shame if the 'Green' was lost to housing so that the current youngsters who live on the estate had nowhere to play football or cricket like I used to all those years ago. It is the only green space on the whole estate so if it was lost to housing the youngsters would have to play on the roads and this would be extremely dangerous.

Samantha Gegg

I have lived in Rudloe for 12 years and while I don't use the green myself, I do see how it benefits the local kids and families. With Rudloe being a slightly isolated estate, I feel it is important to what recreation space we have. Some kids/families might not be able to travel to other parks/play spaces so where will they go if they build on the green? It is important that kids have easily accessible play facilities.

I understand that the authority has plans to transfer the disused Rudloe Community Centre to GreenSquare, the areas social housing provider. Whilst I'm not against this particular transaction, and although I would prefer for it to remain Community Centre providing services to the local community, I accept the transfer may be the only way forward. However, I understand that there is a possibility that along with the Centre, Rudloe Green may also be transferred to GreenSquare, for housing to be built.

As a resident of Rudloe Estate of over 60 years, I believe that losing the Green would have a severe adverse effect on the local community; the area is devoid of local amenities. Losing the Green for houses to be built would overcrowd the estate (both people and cars) and would be detrimental and positively dangerous to all those who currently live there. I know from personal experience that the Green is still used on a daily basis by children and parents alike. I used to play on the Green as a child in the 1960s, my children played there in the 1970s and 1980s, and my older grandchildren used the Green in the 1990s until mid 2010s! Also, my younger grandchildren now use the Green for recreational purposes.

The Green has been used by several generations for sport, general play, family days and other social related events.

Please do not proceed with the proposal to transfer the Green to GreenSquare, it should be retained as a community asset and registered as a Village Green!
